

Differences between Bible versions: a few examples ... all the words in capitals are either missing or have been changed in modern versions.

They are all to be found in the KJV.  
Compare with your Bible.

1 John 5:7

“For there are three that bear record in heaven, THE FATHER, THE WORD, AND THE HOLY GHOST: AND THESE THREE ARE ONE.”

Comment: this verse clearly teaches the Trinity, and who they are.

Acts 8:36-37

“See, here is water; what doth hinder me to be baptized?”

AND PHILIP SAID, IF THOU BELIEVEST WITH ALL THINE HEART, THOU MAYEST. AND HE ANSWERED AND SAID, I BELIEVE THAT JESUS CHRIST IS THE SON OF GOD.”

Comment: faith saves us, not baptism (whole of verse 37 is missing from the NIV. Others have it bracketed, or in footnotes)

Isaiah 14:12

“How thou art fallen from heaven, O LUCIFER, son of the morning! How art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!”

Comment: “helel” (Hebrew, original) and “Lucifer” (Latin, in the KJV) both mean “shining one” or “light-bearer”. They do not mean “star”. The word for “star” is not in this verse, so why do modern versions put it in? (Jesus is the Morning Star, not Satan)

Revelation 22:16 “I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the off-spring of David, and the bright and morning star.”

John 7:8-10

“Go ye up unto this feast: I go not up YET unto this feast: for my time is not yet fully come. When he had said these words unto them, he abode still in Galilee. But when his brethren were gone up, then went he also up unto the feast, not openly, but as it were in secret.”

Comment: by taking out the word “yet”, Jesus is made out to be a liar.

Matthew 5:22

“But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother WITHOUT A CAUSE shall be in danger of the judgement.”

Comment: by taking out a cause, all anger becomes sin, and Jesus is made out to be a sinner.

Mark 3:5 “And when he had looked round about on them with anger, being grieved for the hardness of their hearts ...”

Ephesians 4:26 says it is possible to be angry and not sin.

1 Timothy 3:16

“And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: GOD was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.”

Comment: this verse shows that Jesus is God.

Micah 5:2

“But thou, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, FROM EVERLASTING.”

Comment: Jesus is not just from ancient times, nor does He have an origin (NLT). He has been forever, therefore He must be God.

Zechariah 13:6

“And one shall say unto him, What are these wounds in thine HANDS? Then he shall answer, Those with which I was wounded in the house of my friends.”

Comment: this is a prophecy of the crucifixion, completely negated by modern versions.

2 Corinthians 2:17

“For we are not as many, which CORRUPT the word of God: but as of sincerity, but as of God, in the sight of God speak we in Christ.”

Comment: corrupting the word is wrong, not selling it, or you wouldn't be able to buy a Bible!

1 Peter 2:2 “As newborn babes, desire the pure milk OF THE WORD, that ye may grow thereby.”

Comment: this verse shows us what to do to grow - read the Word!

Isaiah 7:14

“Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold a VIRGIN shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.”

Comment: by taking away this miracle, Jesus becomes just a man, not God.

Luke 2:27-33

“And he came by the Spirit into the temple: and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him after the custom of the law, then took he him up in his arms, and blessed God, and said, Lord, now wettest thou thy servant depart in peace, according to thy word: for mine eyes have seen thy salvation, which thou hast prepared before the face of all people; a light to lighten the Gentiles, and the glory of thy people Israel. And JOSEPH and his mother marvelled at those things which were spoken of him.”

Comment: the Scripture makes it clear that Joseph is not Jesus' father,

Colossians 1:14

“In whom we have redemption THROUGH HIS BLOOD, even the forgiveness of sins.”

Comment: we are forgiven because Jesus died for us.

Matthew 27:3-4

“Then Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he was condemned, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, saying, I have sinned in that I have betrayed THE innocent blood.”

Comment: there is only one who is totally innocent.

Mark 2:17

“I came not to call the righteous, but sinners, TO REPENTANCE”

Comment: sinners are called, but they can continue in sin?

2 Timothy 2:15

“STUDY to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needed not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.”

Comment: only the KJV tells us how to be approved by God: to study His Word!

Luke 4:4

“And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, BUT BY EVERY WORD OF GOD.”

Comment: here Jesus quotes Deuteronomy 8:3, showing us that life is to be found in God's Word.

### Warnings against changing the Word of God!!!!

Deuteronomy 4:2

“Ye shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish ought from it, that ye may keep the commandments of the Lord God which I command you.” (Prov 30: 5-6)

Revelation 22:18-19

“For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in the book: and if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things that are written in this book.”
